### Sub: 25<sup>th</sup>Delhi State Inter School Shooting Competition for MQS

#### Dear Members,

We wish to inform you that the All India Inter School Shooting Competition is being organized by NRAI at Asansol, West Bengal from  $18^{th} - 24^{th}$ of September 2022 and the last date for submission of entry for this competition is  $9^{th}$  Sep 2022. This gives us a window of just 9 days to conduct our Delhi State Inter School Shooting Competition, which is a very short notice for organizing a competition, moreover Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges are also not available due to National Junior Shooting Camp.

Under these circumstances we have requested NRAI to accept the scores of the latest Delhi State Shooting Championship as the Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) and they have agreed to consider the result of 37<sup>th</sup> DSSC 2022 as MQS for participating in this competition. However there may be some school students who did not shoot in the 37<sup>th</sup> DSSC NR/ ISSF matches or who could not achieve the required score, hence to give an opportunity to such shooters, DSRA is organizing the 25<sup>th</sup> Delhi State Inter School Shooting Competition for MQS at Deep Memorial Public School, Ghaziabad, U.P. on 4<sup>th</sup>& 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

Participation in this competition is permitted to only those school students who have not achieved the required MQS for participating in the All India Inter School Competition. It is clarified that there will be no ranking / medals for participants in this competition as the sole purpose of this competition is to offer an opportunity to school students to achieve the MQS for participating in the All India Inter School Shooting Competition.

Those who are interested in participating in this competition are requested to go through the following instructions:-

1. As per new norms of NRAI, all Delhi domicile school students above 10 years of age, who have registered themselves as shooters of Delhi and applied for NRAI Shooter ID under DELHI are eligible to participate in this competition. It is clarified that Shooters belonging to Delhi who are studying in schools outside Delhi can also participate in this competition. Shooters belonging to other states who are studying in schools located in Delhi are not permitted to participate in this competition as they will need to participate in the Inter School Shooting Competition organized by their home state.

- 2. The scores achieved during this competition in National Rules (NR) Category matches will only be considered as Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) for participation in the next All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship. The ISSF Matches are only for the shooters who have participated in any ISSF category matches in past, therefore new shooters or those who have not qualified for participating in ISSF category matches should participate in NR category matches only.
- 3. If any shooter who is already qualified for participating in the upcoming All India Inter School Shooting Competition participates in this competition then he / she will be disqualified and a penalty of Rs. 1000/- will be imposed on them.
- 4. The entry of this competition can be submitted with Mr. Ravinder Kumar (92137-95291) at DSRA office located at B-211, Okhla Industrial Area, Phase I, New Delhi till 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 2022 (Till 6:00 pm) after which entries can be submitted at the venue latest by 12:00 p.m on 5<sup>th</sup> of September 2022. The entry form duly attested by school authorities should be accompanied with Municipal Birth Certificate/ NRAI Shooter ID and TWO PASSPORT SIZE PHOTO of the student.
- 5. The time, date and the detail in which a shooter will shoot his / her match will be on first come first serve basis. Participants can contact Mr. Ishwinder Singh (9350838418) for further details.
- 6. Those shooters who do not have NRAI Shooter ID Card, need to apply for NRAI Shooter ID on NRAI website <a href="www.thenrai.org">www.thenrai.org</a> and register themselves with NRAI by uploading their Photograph, MCD Birth certificate, Passport, Adhaar Card etc after which, the provisional NRAI Shooter ID Card Number will be generated instantly which can be used for submission of All India Inter School entry on NRAI Website.
- 7. The entry form duly signed and stamped by the school authority should be submitted along with a self attested copy of municipal Birth certificate or NRAI Shooter ID Card.
- 8. Participation in various age category matches will be as per Rule 11 of NRAI Match Book. The age of the shooter (Junior below the age of 19 years, Youth below the age of 18 years and Sub Youth below the age of 15 years) will be calculated from the first day of the competition, (18th September, 2022 of the All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Competition 2022).
- 9. \_Those NR shooters who have achieved 75% of the MQS as per Annexure B and ISSF shooters who have achieved 85% of the MQS as per Annexure B/1 would have achieved the required MQS and

be eligible to participate in All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Competition 2022. This is as per the Circular dated 25 August 2022 issued by the NRAI for the XXIV All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Competition 2022 in Air Weapon events at Asansol Rifle Club, Chanmari, Paschim Bardhaman, Asansol, West Bengal from 18th to 24th September, 2022.

- 10. Shooters can participate in one category either in Junior, Youth Category or in Sub Youth category but not in both more than one.
- 11. A shooter can participate either in NR Category matches or ISSF category matches but not in both.
- 12. A shooter can participate in ISSF category match only if he/ she has participated in any ISSF category matches in past but failed to achieve the required MQS for participating in All India Inter School Shooting Competition.
- 13. Shooters who have already participated in any ISSF category matches organized by DSRA or NRAI are not permitted to participate in N.R. Matches of this competition. If any shooter who has already participated in any ISSF category match in past participates in a N.R. category match of this competition then he / she will be disqualified.
- 14. There will be no team event in this competition.
- 15. There will be no prize distribution ceremony for this competiton
- 16. Delhi State Rifle Association reserves the right to alter any condition of this competition to ensure smooth conduct of this competition.
