36th DELHI STATE SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP - 2021

Dear Members,

We wish to inform you that due to the unfortunate Covid-19 pandemic crises, the 36th Delhi State Shooting Championship will be held only for N.R. category matches with a view to afford an opportunity to beginner level shooters to qualify for participating in the upcoming North Zone / All India G.V. Mavalankar competition. The venue and the dates of the competition is as under:-

1. **10 Mtr Air Rifle / Air Pistol (N.R) Matches** – The 10 Mtr Air Rifle / Air Pistol matches in N.R. category will be held on SIUS Electronic Scoring Targets (EST) at Deep Memorial Public School, A-Block, Ramprastha Colony, Surya Nagar, Ghaziabad, U.P from 5th to 12th of February 2021 as per the following **tentative** schedule of competition.

2. **Shotgun Matches in Trap, Skeet & Double Trap (N.R) Matches** – The shotgun matches in Trap, Skeet and Double Trap (N.R) category will be held at Manav Rachna Shooting Ranges, Village Pali, Gothda Mohbtabad, Haryana from 5th to 8th of Feb 2021 as per attached schedule of competition.

3. **25 / 50 Mtr Pistol (N.R) Matches and 50 Mtr Rifle (N.R) Matches** – The 25 / 50 Mtr Pistol events in N.R. category and 50 Mtr Rifle events in N.R Category will be held at Jaspal Rana Shooting Ranges, Village Mazhon, P.O. Pondha, Dehradun, Uttarakhand (GPS Coordinates – 30°23'01.0"N 77°59'06.6"E) from **14th Feb 2021 to 19th Feb 2021** as per attached schedule of competition.

4. Shooters who have participated in ISSF category match of a particular event in past are not permitted to participate in that particular event during this competition, however he / she is permitted to participate in other events if he/ she has not participated in ISSF category match of that event in past. **If any shooter who has participated in ISSF event in past participates in this competition in that particular event then he / she will be disqualified.**
5. The competition is open to all members of Delhi State Rifle Association. In addition, Non-Members who are permanent residents of Delhi are also permitted to participate and they will be eligible for medal and ranking.
6. **Participants of firearm events (25 Mtr / 50 Mtr & Shotgun) will have to make their own arrangement of weapon and ammunition for practice and match.**
7. **Shooters who are residents of other states are not permitted to participate in this competition as there will be NO GUEST ENTRY MATCHES IN THIS COMPETITION.**
8. **There will be no team entry in any event.**
9. The matches will be conducted according to NRAI Match Book, however we reserve the right to alter any rule for the smooth conduct of the competition.
10. The dates of the competition can be reduced / extended depending on the number of entries received.



11. The minimum age for participation in Air Rifle / Air Pistol is 10 years and for firearms events the minimum age for participation is 12 years. **Shooters below the age of 21 years, below the age of 19, below the age of 16 years as on the date of starting of competition will be considered as Junior, Youth and Sub youth category shooters respectively.**
12. Sub Youth category Shooter can participate in Sub youth, Youth, Junior and Senior Category similarly Youth category shooters can participate in Youth, Junior and Senior category likewise Junior category shooter can participate in both Junior and Senior category. Shooters aged 60 years or above can participate in the Veteran category.
13. Finals will not be conducted for any event.
14. **Shooters of 10 Mtr Air Rifle / Air Pistol are informed that the lanes will be automatically pre-allotted and shooters will have to shoot in the particular detail and lane allotted to them. The allocation of detail and lanes will be shared on DSRA website before the start of the match. Shooters are advised to check the lane / detail allotted to them and report half an hour prior to the start time of their detail. The request for change of lanes will be at the discretion of organizers subject to availability of lanes without causing disturbance to the schedule of competition.**
15. The last date for submission of online entry is **1st of February 2021**, after which late entry will be accepted on payment of Triple Entry Fee.
16. Entry for this competition are **ONLINE only**, Shooters who are already registered with NRAI can log on www.thenrai.org to submit your entry, while the shooters who are not registered with NRAI will need to register themselves as shooters on NRAI portal and generate a new User Name and Password which will enable them to create a Shooter ID on NRAI Portal www.thenrai.org . Once you log on the website a shooter can simply select the matches he / she wishes to participate in and save the entry, after the approval of the entry the participant will need to deposit the entry fee online and take a printout of their competitor card online.
17. The Prize distribution ceremony will be held in Delhi, the venue and timing of the same will be shared in due course of time and the information regarding the same will be posted on DSRA website.
18. Certificates for individual matches will be issued only to those shooters who achieve minimum qualifying score (MQS) as per rule no. 1.4 of NRAI match book which is reproduced below.
19. The score achieved by shooters in this competition would be considered as minimum qualifying score (MQS) for participating in the next All India G.V. Mavalankar Shooting Competition / North Zone Shooting Championship. The MQS to participate in North Zone /All India G.V. Mavalankar Shooting Competition is as follows:-
